- Systematic process
- Evaluation of :
 - Social Value
 - Relevance
 - Scientific validity
 - Dissemination Plan
 - Informed consent process
 - Management of vulnerability

- Management of Research Risks
- Balance of Risks and Benefits
- Protection of Privacy
 - Equitable distribution of burdens and benefits
- Transparency
 - COI

WHO DOES ETHICS REVIEW IN THE PHILIPPINES?

IRB, ERC, REC, IERB:

-a committee designated by an institution/ authority to conduct ethical evaluation of a proposed study involving human participants, its implementation and final reporting.
